
EQUANS Group – At a Glance

- One of the largest DHN **decarbonisation** initiative in the UK with plans to be Net Zero.









Our Strategy





London Borough of Enfield

EQUANS was appointed to deliver England's largest at the time shared ground source heat pump system by Enfield Council. This revolutionary project is being carried out in partnership with contractor Kensa, which specialises in Ground Source Heat Pump (GSHP) Energy systems and will serve eight blocks of flats across two estates.

More than 400 residents will benefit from geothermal energy to heat their homes, which has virtually no impact on the environment, with an expected 30-50% savings on their heating bills each year. GSHP is an environmentally friendly and cost-effective system, having exceptionally low servicing and maintenance costs and the assurance of providing reliable service long into the future



East London Energy

The Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park and Stratford City District Energy Scheme is operated and maintained by EQUANS East London Energy Ltd (ELE). ELE plays a key role in London's climate change strategy and in meeting the Mayor of London's vision for sustainable development.

In 2008, EQUANS was awarded a 40-year concession to design, finance and build the energy centres and network on behalf of the Olympic Delivery Authority and Stratford City Developments Ltd; providing a source of low carbon heating, hot and chilled water to the Olympic Park and the surrounding area.
